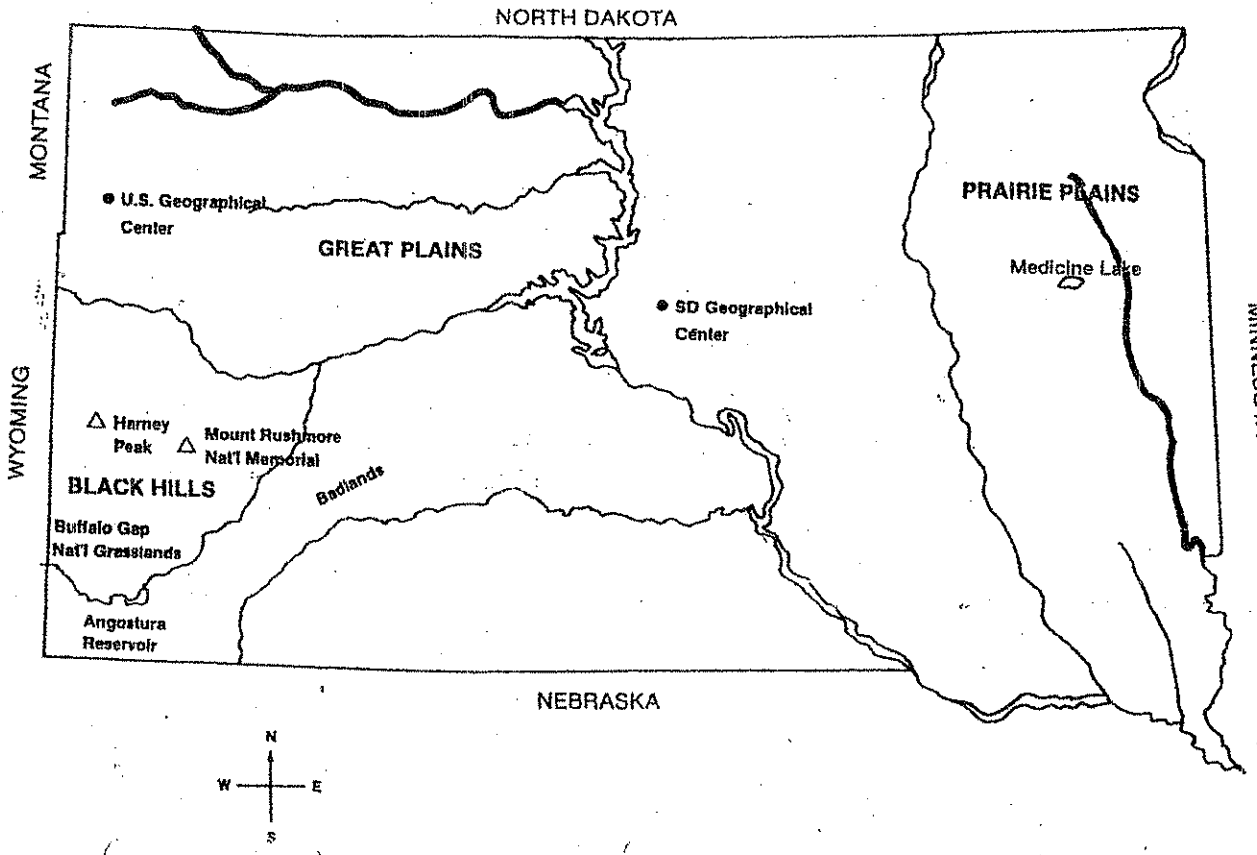
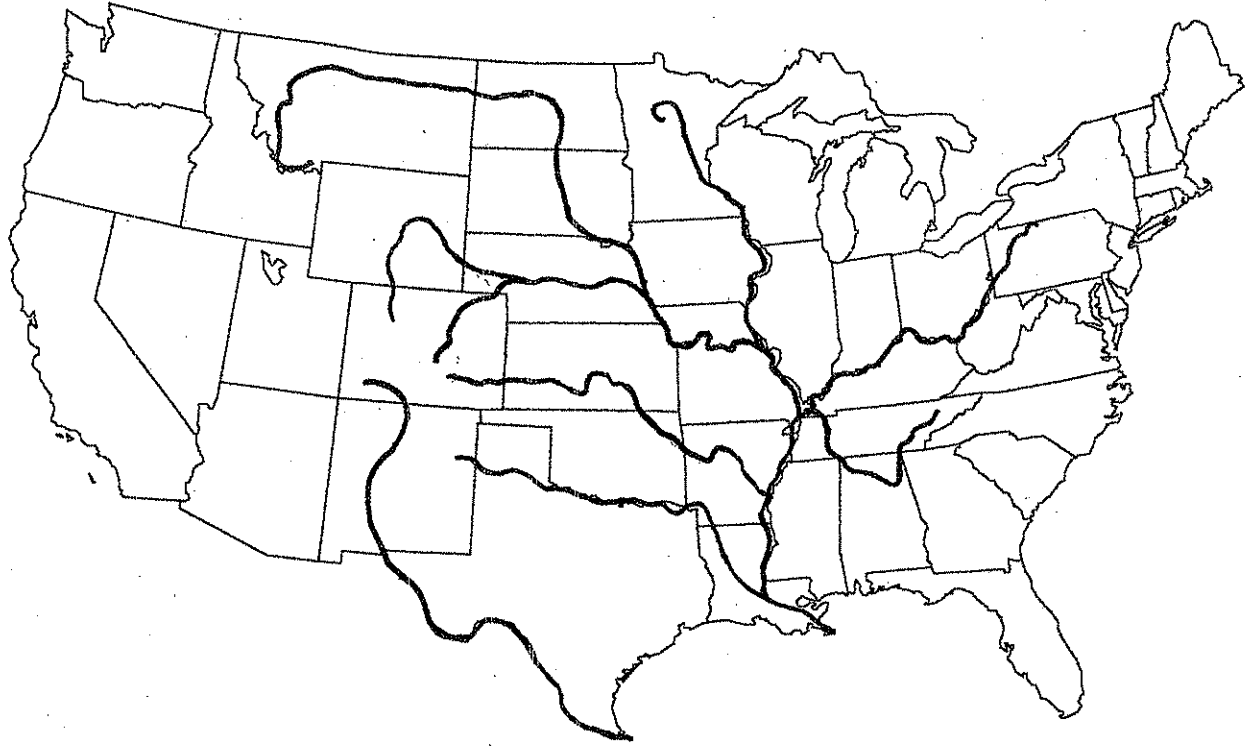


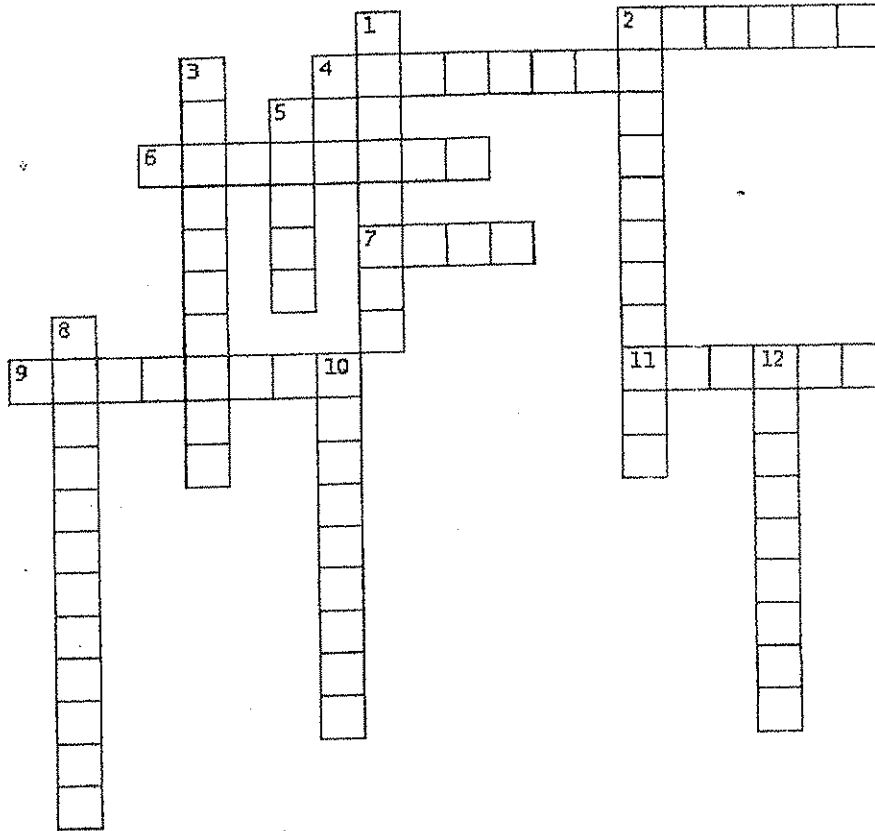

- 2 This river is named after a French trader
- 4 Has been nicknamed "Big Muddy" because of all of the silt (dirt) carried by it.
- 6 Former President Bill Clinton is from the state where this river connects with the Mississippi.
- 7 Formed by the merging of two rivers, the Allegheny and the Monongahela.
- 9 This river was the center point for a campaign during the Civil War.
- 11 This word in French means shallow.

- 1 Empties into the Missouri River around Sioux City, Iowa.
- 2 This river was immortalized by Tom Sawyer and Huck Finn.
- 3 This river flooded in 1881. The town it flooded was moved up to higher ground nearby.
- 5 This is sometimes called the Jim or the Dakota River
- 8 This river in French means "beautiful fork"
- 10 This river is the 20th longest in the world.
- 12 A U-shaped river named after an Indian Village nearby.
